

Kiev Polytechnic Institute of National Technical University of Ukraine

Specialty: It was founded in 1898 and mainly trains engineers and specialists in technical fields: Electrical Engineering, Electromechanics, Mining, Ecology, Heat and Power Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Applied Physics and Mathematics, Telecommunications, Computer Technology, Chemical Technology, Welding Technologies, Metallurgy, Nuclear Power Engineering, Tool Production, Measuring Technologies, Aircraft and Rocket Production, Management, Marketing, Printing and Publishing, Biotechnology, Radio Engineering. Base: the biggest Ukrainian university. It includes 18 faculties, 7 educational and scientific institutes, joint Mechanical Engineering Faculty, 15 research and development institutes and scientific centers and an engineering bureau.

Famous graduates: Igor Sikorskiy (creator of the first helicopters), Sergei Korolyov (creator of the first space rocket), Boris Paton (world famous academician in metallurgy and technology of metals), Yuriy Gogotsi (Materials Science professor, founder and Director of Nanomaterials Institute in the USA) and others.

Tuition fee: \$3000 – \$4500 per year.

Kiev International University

Specialty: It was founded in 1994. It trains specialists in International Relations as well as economists, psychologists, linguists, lawyers, specialists in cinematic and dramatic art, journalists, builders and architects and medical workers.

Base: It includes 3 institutes, 3 faculties, 3 educational and scientific institutes.

Tuition fee: \$15 000 per year.

Kiev National Economic University named after Vadim Hetman.

Specialty: the biggest economic educational institution, a training center for economists, managers and law scholars recognized in Ukraine and in the world. It was founded in 1906.

Base: 9 faculties, 17 institutes, 1 research and development institute, 6 colleges.

Tuition fee: \$15 000 per year.

Taras Shevchenko National University of Kiev

Specialty: Trains specialists in Geography, History, Jurisprudence, Economics, Information Technologies, Cybernetics, Psychology, Radio Physics, Electronics and Computer Systems, Sociology, Philosophy, Physics.

Base: 14 humanitarian and science faculties were created as well as 7 educational institutes which have ca. 25 000 students. The University also has Physical and Mathematical Lyceum, Information and Computer Center, Publishing and Polygraphic Center, several Astronomical Observatories, a library, Fomin Botanical Garden and Kanev Conservation Area.

Tuition fee: \$25 000 per year.

National Pedagogical Dragomanov University.

Specialty: name Ukrainian institution of higher education of III—IV levels of accreditation. In 1834 Pedagogical Institute started its work as a structural subdivision of Saint Vladimir University. It trains specialists in Philosophy, Engineering and Pedagogical field, Computing Science, Foreign Philology, Psychology, Arts, Pedagogy and Psychology, Political Science and Law, Management and Economics.

Base: Consists of 18 institutes. One of them is Ukrainian-American Institute of Humanities “Wisconsin International University” (USA) in Ukraine of National Pedagogical Dragomanov University and another one is Continental University of National Pedagogical Dragomanov University.

Famous graduates: Oksana Bairak - a famous Ukrainian film director, Roman Bessmertnyi – a former Vice-Prime Minister, Minister of Ukraine, Augusta Goldberg – the first Doctor of Psychology in Ukraine, Vitalii and Vladimir Klichko — world famous boxers, world champions.

Tuition fee: 6 500 – 19 000 UAH per year.

Kiev National University of Technologies and Design

Specialty: Kiev National University of Technologies and Design was founded in 1930. It is a Ukrainian institution of higher education of the IV level of accreditation. It trains specialists in Economics and Business, Design, Technologies, Service and Fashion, Chemical and Biopharmaceutical Technologies, Mechatronics and Computer Technologies as well as Market, Information and Innovation Technologies.

Base: 6 faculties, 5 institutes, 3 colleges.

Tuition fee: \$1 000 – \$3 100 per year.

Kiev National Aviation University

Specialty: Independent history of this University began in 1933. The University trains specialists in engineering fields as well as economists, lawyers, ecologists, translators, psychologists, sociologists and others.

Base: It includes 20 institutes, 7 colleges, 2 lyceums and 1 academy.

Tuition fee: \$5 000 – \$6 000 per year.

National University of Kiev-Mohila Academy

Specialty: The University positions itself as a legal successor of Kiev-Mohila Academy (1659—1817) which makes it one of the three oldest universities of Ukraine after Ostrog Academy and Lvov University as well as one of the oldest institutions of higher education in Eastern Europe. Its Statute (1620) was based on the Statute of Lvov brethren school. Kiev Academy became a source of education in Russia. It was graduates of Kiev Academy who founded first institutions of higher education in Russia and besides 80% of the academic staff there were graduates of Kiev Academy. The University trains specialists in Humanities, Economics, Computing Science, Legal Science, Natural Science, Social Science and Social Technologies.

Base: It has 6 faculties

Famous graduates: Daniil Pavlovich Apostol— hetman of Zaporozhie troops from 1727 until 1734. Piotr Dorofeevich Doroshenko (1627 — 1698) — hetman of Zaporozhie troops in right-bank Ukraine in 1665—1676. Skovoroda Grigorii Savvich – a Ukrainian classic writer.

Tuition fee: \$20 000-\$37 000 per year.

Boris Grinchenko Kiev University

Specialty: modern institution of higher education of Kiev territorial community. The University provides continuous training of specialists in accordance with international standards– from junior specialists to doctoral students – as well as postgraduate studies for teachers of Ukrainian educational institutions. It was founded in 1874. It trains specialists in Engineering Pedagogy, Foreign Philology, Computing Science, History, Arts, Pedagogy and Psychology, Ecology, Political Science and Law, Physical Education and Sport, Philosophy and Physics and Mathematics field.

Base: It includes 6 institutes, 1 college

Tuition fee: \$2 000 per year.

Kharkov National University of Radio Electronics

Specialty: Technical University in Kharkov. It was founded in 1962 as Kharkov Institute of Mining Machinery Manufacturing, Automatics and Computer Engineering.

Afterwards it was named Kharkov Institute of Radio Electronics. It trains specialists in Computer Science, Computer Engineering and Management, Applied Mathematics and Management, Radio Technology, Telecommunications and Measuring Equipment, Automatics and Computer Technologies, Electronic Engineering.

Base: It includes 9 faculties.

Famous graduates: Diomin Oleg— an Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Ukraine in People's Republic of China. Anikeev Yuriy — a Ukrainian sportsman, world champion in checkers. Severinskiy Alexander – the inventor of the high voltage power system for a hybrid electro-petrol car.

Tuition fee: \$1 500 – \$4 000 per year

V.N. Karazin Kharkov National University

Specialty: one of the oldest universities of Eastern Europe. It was officially opened on 17 January 1805. It is the oldest classic university on Ukrainian lands of the Russian Empire and the second in modern Ukraine after Lvov University. It is the fifth university in the Russian Empire after Vilna, Derpt, Moscow and Kazan Universities. It trains specialists in Law, Chemistry, Biology, Geography, Geology, Ecology, Economics, Marketing, Management, Finance and Audit, Tourism, International Economic Relations, International Law, Hotel and Catering Business, History, Philology, Mathematics, Mechanics, Psychology, Political Science, Advertisement and Public Relations, Computer Science, System Engineering, Applied Physics, Astronomy, Journalism.

Base: 19 faculties, 1 Institute of High Technologies (3 faculties), 9 research and development establishments.

Famous graduates: Iliya Mechnikov — a Russian and French biologist and Nobel laureate in Physiology and Medical Science (1908). Lev Landau — an outstanding Soviet theoretical physicist and Nobel laureate in Physics of 1962. P.P. Gulak-Artemovskiy, a Ukrainian writer, poet, translator.

Kharkov Polytechnic Institute

Specialty: Kharkov Polytechnic Institute of National Technical University, founded in 1885, is the oldest technical institution of higher education of left-bank Ukraine. It trains specialists in Automatics and Tool Production, Business and Finance, Engineer Physics, Law, Philosophy, Ethics, Integrated Technology and Chemical Engineering, Computer Science and Management, Computer and Information Technologies, Mechanical

Engineering, Humanities, Natural Science, Social and Economic Science, Mechanical Technology, Technology of Inorganic Substances, Technology of Organic Substances, Transport Engineering, Engineering Physics.

Base: It includes 21 faculties.

Famous graduates: Landau Lev— Nobel laureate, Hero of socialist labour, laureate of 1 Lenin and 3 Stalin awards. He was the Head of the Theoretical Physics Chair at Kharkov Mechanic and Machine Building Institute from 1933 until 1937. The first honorary Doctors of Kharkov Polytechnic Institute of National Technical University were outstanding scientists professors Mendeleev D.I. and Zhukovskiy N.

Kharkov National Medical University

Specialty: institution of higher education for training of highly qualified medical specialists. It is located in Kharkov and was founded in 1805.

Base: It includes 8 faculties, 6 educational research and practice associations, 1 college and 2 scientific institutes.

Famous graduates: Alpern Daniil — a pathophysiologist, a corresponding member of USSR, an Honoured Science Worker of USSR, Head of Pathophysiology Chair of Kharkov Medical Institute (1929—1968). Bogatyryova Raisa — an obstetrician-gynecologist, a statesperson, Health Minister of Ukraine (2000).

Tuition fee: \$21 000 – \$23 100 per year
